WHEREAS, it is important to recognize organizations that specialize in community endeavors that motivate those who not only strive for goals but also help in reaching them; and

WHEREAS, the Self-Help Housing Corporation of Hawai'i (SHHCH) is a non-profit, private corporation that provides any qualifying family with a house, provided they put in labor toward the building of it; and

WHEREAS, in the Poka'i Bay Subdivision along the Wai'anae Coast, the SHHCH will undertake 6 self-help housing projects of 11-12 families each, jumpstarting a brand new life for those who never would've achieved the fruits of their labor otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Poka'i Bay Self-Help Housing Project is the 53rd project initiated by the SHHCH which has completed 656 houses throughout the State of Hawai'i, and more than 50,000 houses nationwide. Funded in part by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, it is a source for land acquisition and infrastructure; now, therefore,


